MARCHING UNIFORM CARE AGREEMENT**

Our uniforms identify us and bring us together as a unit. Whether performing, rehearsing, or traveling, our uniformed appearance says a great deal about who we are.

The Instrumentalist Marching Uniform: An Instrumental student is issued a Marching Band Uniform Valued at over \$472.75 that includes: uniform jacket \$155, green overlay \$60, bib pants \$60, black gauntlets \$30/pr., green gauntlet \$21, black/silver insert \$60, shako \$43, shako box \$12.00, plume \$16.50, garment bag \$12.25, black or white gloves \$2.60, marching shoes \$28.50 and Tuba Hats \$24.00. Additionally, students wear their own or school loaned black socks and school loaned plain black, no-logo sleeved t-shirt.

The Color Guard Marching Uniform: Color Guard student is issued a field uniform valued at \$200. Members wear their own or school loaned tights and shoes for the field uniform performance.

When the band travels, Members wear their own or school loaned alternate band wear consisting of a specified alternate shirt (black, green or white depending on event shirts), dark black shorts or pants, plain back jacket or letterman, and sneakers. No open toed shoes or flip-flops. (Loaned or owned)

Pre-season Uniform Preparation: NEVER CUT ANY PART OF THE JACKET OR PANTS. A HOT IRON MELTS THESE FABRICS. YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR DAMAGE TO THE CVUSD MARCHING UNIFORM.

Black socks and a plain black T-shirt are worn under the uniform. Write your name on your personal items so that they can be returned to you if found.

Performance Days: Instrumentalists are responsible for wearing black clean shoes, black socks, and a black no logo t-shirt in your labeled shoe bag. For all football games, you also need your black baseball hat. If your uniform is home, bring it! All pieces should be hung properly on the hangers provided. Please don't dump the pants in the bottom of the bag. They will be all wrinkled and look unkept. Do not store the shoe bag inside garment bag. While in uniform, street clothes and shoes go in shoe bag. There will be racks outside the band room on performance days. Hang your uniform bag, in numerical order, on those racks. Shoe bag goes with instrument, in locker or green cans. Color Guard members will hang their uniform in the garment bag and carry all other performance items in their own guard bags.

Performance Itineraries are provided on the Band Calendar. Please Read them! Check that you have every part of the uniform needed for this performance.

Uniform Accessories: Instrumentalist gloves are part of the performance uniform. The band program provides a new pair each year along with Shakos/plumes and Tuba hats. Any lost or damaged hats or gloves are the financial responsibility of the student to purchase a replacement.

All members should contact the uniform boosters if your jacket or any part of the uniform is damaged, needs repair or is soiled or is getting too tight or too loose.

We have read and agree to the conditions stated in the TOHS Instrumental Music Dept. Uniform Care Agreement. Any lost or damaged parts to the issued uniform are the financial responsibility of the student/parent for replacement.
