Concert Bands

We are working hard, in class, preparing 6 pieces (per band) for the upcoming Spring Concert. Our final performance list will be chosen from the 6 pieces and then we will select our Rating's Festival music, 3 for Symphonic Band and 2 for Wind Symphony and Wind Ensemble.

It's so great to hear the improvement in the ensemble on a week-to-week basis. Parents, I ask that you get involved in having your student practice at home... at least 4 times a week for a min. of 30 minutes per day. That will do so much for their confidence and preparedness for all of this literature.

There is a strong potential that students will need to fulfill a graded playing assessment(s) in the upcoming weeks. I hope that we can increase the total number submissions for all three bands. It is true that we are only as good as the individual player.

Jazz Bands

That is correct... 2 bands!!! I have assigned musicians to two individual bands. We are doubling some musicians to cover the parts in both bands. We are currently working on 6 pieces for AM 1 and 4 for AM 2. While this is a challenge for all of us, the members are responding well and are excited to see how far we can take this.

Both AM 1 and AM 2 will perform at the Newbury Park High School Jazz Festival on Saturday, March 14th. The John Daversa Band will perform a concert at NPHS on

Friday, March 13th as a kick off to the festival. Ticket information can be found at the NPHS Band Website.

And of course, we have the Sights of Conejo Performance in the TOHS Gym on Saturday, March 7.
